

4 Parts of the Sacrament of Reconciliation

Examination of Conscience:

(EXAMINE) Before you arrive, ask God for help in remembering your sins, specific actions and general patterns of behavior, use the examination of conscience on the back of this page. Think about how you have sinned.

(CONTRITION) Be sorry for your sins have good intentions to not sin again.

Go to the Priest:

The priest will welcome you and you will both make the sign of the cross; the priest will pray for you and may read a scripture passage.

Confess your sins:

(CONFESS) Tell the Priest your sins and ask for forgiveness. Tell him that you know in your heart that what you did was wrong and that you are confident that you will not sin again. The Priest will discuss your sins with you and provide spiritual advice.

Receive a Penance:

(PENANCE) The priest will talk to you about doing something as a sign of your desire to change your behavior and not sin again. It may be saying some prayers or doing some loving action.

Tell God that you are truly sorry:

Pray the *Act of Contrition* or *Prayer of Sorrow* or use your own words to tell God that you are truly sorry for sins with the Priest.

Receive absolution:

(ABSOLUTION) The Priest extends his hands over the penitent's head and prays the words of absolution and God forgives your sins.

Change my ways:

(CONVERSION) Try your best to change your ways. Avoid situations that might lead you to sin. Remember to live Christ's greatest commandments to love God with your whole heart, soul and mind and love your neighbor as yourself.

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

- Do I ever make promises that I do not keep?
- Do I ever cheat on tests or schoolwork?
- Do I take things that do not belong to me?

- Do I treat the property of others with respect and care?
- Do I share what I have with others?
- Do I respect and care for all of God's creatures and creation?

Our Father
